



Aprylle Gilbert's Coast to Coast Run for Disadvantaged Kids

Heads up Nevada. Here Comes Gilbert!

After covering more than 800 miles in a little less than four weeks, San Francisco Bay area endurance runner and mother of two left California and entered Nevada today on her coast to coast charity run along historic Route 6 from Long Beach, CA to Provincetown, MA.

California-Nevada Border — After nearly four weeks and more than 800 miles on the asphalt, Aprylle Gilbert crossed the California border into Nevada today near Benton, CA. Gilbert, an extreme-distance endurance runner from the San Francisco region, is best known as an author and one of the top folk-rock musician in the Bay Area.


On April 28, 2015, Gilbert launched her national charity fund-raising event by running from San Jose, CA to Malibu. On May 11, 2015 in Long Beach, CA, Gilbert took up the challenge of being the first person to run the entire 3,652 miles of historic Route 6. Averaging 30 miles a day, she reached the California / Nevada border on May 30.

Gilbert's run was conceived as a way to help Catholic Charities and Washington United Youth Center in Santa Clara County, CA raise \$100,000 to improve after-school programs for underserved kids. This vision has evolved into a campaign to foster community activism across the nation by encouraging like-minded athletes to raise money for their local charities by running with her for part of the way.
