Truro/Provincetown host hotel destination for early afternoon arrivals. This allows time to explore Provincetown & dine before the evening sock hop & function hall social at the Outer Reach Resort. Faster times and earlier arrival can be attained by using the Interstate 195 and Mid Cape U.S. Route 6 highways should you encounter traffic delays.
